Clarification of News Report

"An attempt by Now Telecom to reverse regulatory structures related to finding the third telco was thwarted on Tuesday by the Manila Regional Trial Court (RTC).

Branch 42 of the Manila RTC trashed its petition asking the National Telecommunications Commission (NTC) to do away with a number of provisions under the so-called terms of reference or ToR that will determine who qualifies in the selection process for the third telco player.

'The case will continue to trial where Now intends to prosecute its rights over the subject matter. The company is confident that its entitlements are guaranteed by law and legal proceedings including those in the Supreme Court. Now Telecom will exhaust all its legal remedies with respect to its prayer for an injunction,' it said in a statement.

'We shall continue our claim for the 140 MHZ frequencies out of the 225 MHZ frequencies being bid out in the NMP bidding by NTC and DICT, among other claims we have made. Fight is not over yet,' it quickly added."

NOW Corporation confirms that its affiliate, NOW Telecom Company, Inc., received the above-quoted ruling from the Manila Regional Trial Court with respect to its request for issuance for Preliminary Injunction. The Corporation does not expect any significant negative change or effect caused by the said Court ruling.
